



We have a lot to thank God for.

Kingdom Bank savers have helped 80 churches, Christian organisations and ministry workers to buy or improve their own property. This has included churches purchasing, developing or refurbishing buildings which have not previously been used for worship and evangelism, including a former bingo hall and social club.

HOW YOUR SAVINGS ARE MAKING A DIFFERENCE

You have enabled us to support churches facing challenging situations, where their landlords have chosen to terminate leases or sell the buildings they currently occupy. By trusting Kingdom Bank with your savings, you have enabled the ministry of these churches to continue in their local communities.

Ministry workers have also faced challenges in a housing market still reeling from sharp interest rate rises and a higher cost of living. You have helped us to provide 20 personal mortgages of over £3m in value.





As a veterinary surgeon, I've enjoyed a successful and fulfilling career. My wife and I are actively involved in our local church, where I occasionally preach. But as I ponder retirement and my share in the business is being released to me, a question weighs on my conscience:

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH THE MONEY?

I've felt a real burden about stewarding this wealth wisely. Luke 18:25 has kept coming to mind – the image of a camel struggling through the eye of a needle. If I'm going to retain money for myself as a retirement fund, could it be put to work to serve God's Kingdom on earth?

OVERWHELMED BY OPTIONS

The sheer number of ethical investment choices is overwhelming. I am still working a busy job, with little time or enthusiasm to research every option. Who could I trust to steward the money wisely and responsibly, giving me peace of mind?

A KINGDOM-MINDED ALTERNATIVE

My wife came across an advertisement for Kingdom Bank. On browsing the website, she showed me promotional images featuring our great friends Dave and Andrea Taylor, missionaries who already used the Bank's mortgage services. We took it as a

Redeemer Church was planted in 2017 from Cornerstone Church, Nottingham. Starting with 80 members, their congregation has grown to 350 attendees on a Sunday. The need to leave rented accommodation for a permanent home – one the church would own – soon became apparent.

FINDING A PERMANENT HOME

In January 2018, Senior Pastor Pete Brown learned the local town hall was due to be sold by the council. He sent a speculative email about the church's potential use of the building to serve the local community and to prevent its demolition. To his surprise,

the council were sympathetic to the church's vision but, when news broke on social media, local opposition quickly followed.

FIERCE PUBLIC BACKLASH

The announcement sparked hostility on local Facebook groups and drew negative cover-

age from radio and TV stations. One Face-book group with 50,000 members became a hub for inflammatory posts opposing the church's bid.

Church members faced direct verbal attacks, being labelled as 'bigots' for their faith.

Pete recalls, "We had to be careful with our engagement with the public because words would get twisted. Any interaction risked fuelling the fire."

Despite warnings from professionals that the sale wouldn't go through due to the backlash, the council remained supportive. Redeemer Church presented their plans for:

- free language classes for non-English speakers,
- a warm welcome space for the elderly,
- a toddler group serving over 100 families, and
- regular community events and facility hire for local groups.

Their commitment to community service swayed the final vote in their favour. The council approved the sale just months before a new administration took office which, Pete believed, opposed the church's purchase.

Some of the loudest critics, a couple who had accused the church of bigotry, attended a community fun day hosted by Redeemer. By the end of the event, they approached a church member and admitted, "We got it wrong. We were the bigots. We're really sorry." They have since attended church events and services.

THE ROLE OF KINGDOM BANK

Pete comments, "When the time came to refinance our high street mortgage, we found Kingdom Bank to be the best option due to:

Church isn't just bricks and mortar, but just like a family needs a home, a building enables more expansive work with security of tenure."



Towy Community Church has been transforming lives in Carmarthenshire since 2001. From feeding families to providing debt advice, their heart is to share the love of God. Fundraiser, Siân Wood comments, "Our vision is that people come to know the love of Jesus through the projects the church is running."

AN UNUSUAL OPPORTUNITY

Having initially met in a school hall, an opportunity arose to acquire a disused dairy factory in 2010. The church also discovered that the council were seeking

an organisation who would develop and run a bowling alley for the benefit of local young people, for whom there was a lack of facilities.

The church agreed to take on this project.

Their vision was to use the same site to host church services, a local Foodbank, a recycled furniture centre for those on low incomes, debt advice services and provide volunteering opportunities to boost self-esteem among young people. While the church accounts are kept separate from the money earned by the project, all the social projects have been part-funded by proceeds from the bowling alley.

MOUNTING COMPLEXITIES

The church's 'Xcel site' was developed. However, multiple loans were required to sustain the projects through the Covid-19 pandemic. This made cash flow complex and applying for grants and funding challenging. These outreach projects had been a lifeline to the community, both for the services offered and jobs they provided, but redundancies loomed, and closure seemed inevitable.

SIMPLIFYING WITH A KINGDOM BANK MORTGAGE

Faced with an uncertain future, the church turned to Kingdom Bank. By consolidating their loans into a single mortgage, they were able to breathe again, freeing up resources to focus on what mattered most: serving their community.



My name is Cathy Dalton. I'm a wife and a mother to two teenage daughters. Like any parent, I think about our family's future and the importance of our financial security. But more than that, I want to ensure that our money is being used in a way that reflects our Christian values.

For a long time, I kept our savings in a high street bank, where it simply sat and earned a small return. It was the traditional approach. Low risk, steady growth. to see that money that would otherwise just be sat in a mainstream bank not doing a great deal can be put to work for the Kingdom."

For me, responsible saving isn't just about the best interest rate. It's about making choices that align with my love for Jesus.
